Picture yourself as an employee of the Coca-Cola Company. A new directive comes down from head office:

“Every individual living in your region should be able to see an appealing ad for Coca-Cola virtually every day.” What do you do with such a tall order? Throw up your hands at the impossibility of it all? Talk a good game, then go through the motions to make it seem like you are complying? Not if you want to keep your job! If you are sufficiently motivated, you find a way.

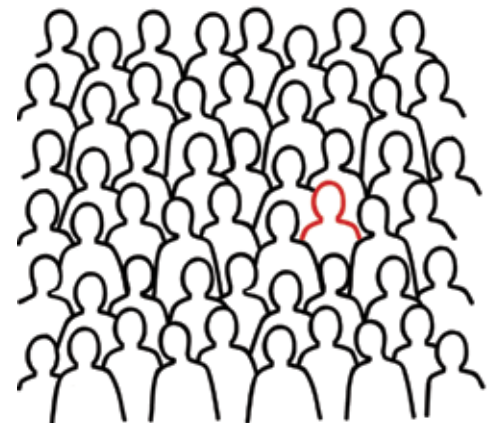
And, of course, Coca-Cola has done exactly that in region after region, country after country, all across the world. Coke’s annual budget for advertising globally exceeds \$3 billion each year.

What about God’s business as conducted by the body of Christ? We have received a similar order from our Head: “Go into all the world and proclaim the Gospel to the whole creation” (Mark 16:15). As various versions show, this means taking the Good News to “every creature”—every individual—worldwide (cf. Colossians 1:23). Again, this order is met with similar reactions: Hands thrown up in disbelief, or a token show of compliance, or trust and obedience that determines to accomplish the mission. Just as a regional manager at Coca-Cola focuses on an assigned territory, each congregation and each Christian has an area of influence.

Typically this begins with our surroundings—our “Jerusalem” (Acts 1:8). Within a defined geographical space, can we make sure that “every creature” has genuine opportunities to hear the Gospel? Unequivocally, YES! Yes, if we really want to! If Coca-Cola can do it for sugar water, we can certainly do it for the glory of God and to rescue as many as possible. If an earthly company can do it by human power, we can certainly succeed by divine power!

An Example of Saturation

John Reese — CEDAR PARK, Texas

God has placed within us a special love for our homeland. In my case there are two: Zimbabwe (where I was born) and the USA (to which my family and I moved in 1991). I praise God that He has empowered the saturation of portions of Zimbabwe with Gospel opportunities.

For World Bible School, the latest impact began in 2007 with “God Bless Africa.” We, along with fellow-Zimbabwean leaders, systematically executed a plan to engage churches of Christ across that nation

as student recruiters. That year, 50,000 new Zimbabweans enrolled in WBS Bible studies, with rapid growth thereafter. Around 2012 we safely estimated 500,000 students in Zimbabwe (“safely” because 300,000 applied in 2011 alone, through Cedar Park alone, one of multiple enrollment avenues). Current and recent WBS students likely number somewhere between 500,000 and 1,000,000—a significant ratio for a nation estimated at 16 million. WBS is a household name in parts of Zimbabwe where virtually “every creature” has received Gospel opportunities through WBS. With so much Gospel seed coming up, follow up workers are hard-pressed to keep up with the harvest—fruit for eternal life!

Can we do the same for sections of America? In some ways, we are better positioned: many mature congregations, generous giving, Internet connectivity and WBS Connect Web ads to which over 200,000 Americans have responded already. One of my first WBS students back in the early 1980s was a young Muslim man named Adjayi Inoussa. After his conversion to Christ, he attended Nigerian Christian College. He preached for many years in French-speaking African countries and is now discipling other preachers as the Assistant Director of the Preacher Training School in Benin. A couple of years ago he baptized his 85-year-old mother, and I recently received word that two more of his five children, Ruth and Gad, have been baptized into Christ.

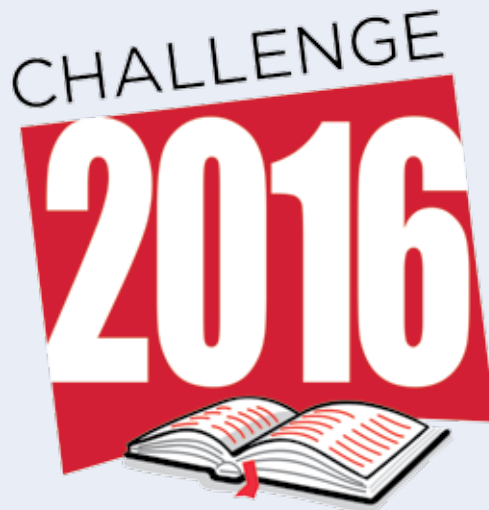

They Yet Speak

Reuel Lemmons was the second director of World Bible School, serving in that capacity from 1984 to 1987. According to his successor, Tex Williams, Reuel preached in 79 nations, as well as all across the United States. He edited Firm Foundation and left behind many writings. We borrow a couple of excerpts here.

Joe Cannon pioneered post-war missions, including new works in Japan and Papua New Guinea. After serving as visiting missionary teacher at Harding College, he continued missionary training in Memphis through Mission 1000. The excerpt below is from his Mission 1000 bulletin *His Harvest*.

Reuel: [The Restoration Movement is] an attempt to get back past Protestantism, which admittedly contained errors inherited from the parent organization, Romanism; back past the apostate church itself—all the way back to the New Testament. Everything not currently practiced in religion that was practiced by the original church was advocated. Everything currently practiced, which the New Testament church did not practice was opposed.

This is not a narrow view. It is the broadest religious view under heaven. We plead for the doing away of creeds, catechisms, confessions of faith, disciplines, manuals and constitutions, and for a uniting of us all on the broad, undenominational, non sectarian basis of the word of God (1955).

We have become almost totally on-evangelistic. We seem to have lost our knowledge of how to convert people. Long range planning of evangelistic priorities is badly needed.... We are depending entirely too much on professionals and have forgotten the priesthood of the individual believer. As a result we are losing ground numerically, and are reaching a smaller percentage of the world's population every year (1986).

Joe: One effort that has shown us “the fields are white unto harvest” is World Bible School. There are thousands of people all over the world interested in studying the Bible. Their letters are piled up everywhere, unanswered because of lack of interest. We have decided to promote WBS as much as possible.

Not all who have trained with us were able to make it to foreign fields. But I want them to know that through WBS they can reach out to the lost of the world from wherever they are. Also, those who are overseas can find in WBS a great tool for contacting and teaching many where they are.

For this reason we are mailing out the names of WBS contacts to you our readers with the hope that you will take a little time to use this teaching method. Don't give up on your vision of world evangelism! You

can go to many nations through this and other Bible correspondence systems.

Once more, let us hear Christ urging us to take another long look at the lost of the world and do more about reaching them.

In Memory of Fran Henson

Fran Henson was 78 years old when she first moved to Waxahachie, Texas.

On her arrival she was upset when the movers dropped her old sewing machine. It was important to her because she had been involved in the “You are Special” program

at Edmond church of Christ in Oklahoma where she had made beautiful dresses for underprivileged girls. Soon her sewing machine was fixed and she made clothes to be given out at our care center. Fran also was deeply concerned with fulfilling the Great Commission and saving souls.

When Fran learned that our congregation [Brown Street, Waxahachie] was involved in World Bible School,

she immediately began diligent work to reach the lost throughout the world. Every week Fran would meet with our WBS teachers and send out as many lessons as possible. Not only did she work with the group, she would take hundreds of lessons home to teach by herself. No one knows for certain how many lessons Fran sent out to Zimbabwe and other developing countries. However, I do know that in one week she sent out 600 lessons.

At the age of 90, Fran was still sending out more WBS lessons than any other person I've ever met. Fran's example inspires us all to be available for God's service, no matter what our age.

In 2015, Sherri Hays at WBS' Cedar Park office processed 790,917 new WBS enrollments worldwide. 250,000 of those new Bible students were from Zimbabwe. (It's interesting to note that John Reese was born in what is now Zimbabwe, part of what was then known as Rhodesia.) This summer Sherri and the Reeses, with others, will be working alongside Christians in Zimbabwe with continuing student recruiting and follow up there.

Like *Action!*, *House to House/Heart to Heart* is published six times a year as a colorful eight pager. While *Action!* addresses you, the Gospel-sharer, *House to House* strengthens the mission by addressing the general public. Currently over 1,000 churches of Christ use customized copies to reach their communities. The total printing each time comes to 2,500,000, which exceeds major newspapers like *The Wall Street Journal* and *USA Today*.

Since its founding by Allen Webster in 1994, over 200 million copies of *House to House* have been sent to communities in all 50 states and in over 60 nations. The entire state of Alabama has received the magazine, and the next goal is all of Tennessee. Luke Griffin says, "We are over 2/3 of the way to that goal." For more detail go to get.housetohouse.com. In addition to editing *House to House*, Allen and the Jacksonville church of Christ in Alabama also host a popular event, *Polishing the Pulpit*, which aims to renew, refresh and recharge God's workers. This year's event will be held in the beautiful Smoky Mountains of Tennessee on August 19-25 when 200 speakers will address 4,000 people in 700 sessions over six days.



Report from Jim Corner

The responsibility for sharing the Gospel rests on the shoulders of every child of God. I became a World Bible School teacher in 1980 and since that time have taught the Gospel to over 1,100 students. Many of them have become our brothers and sisters but equally important is that the seed has been sown. Only the Lord knows the totality of good done through even one soul. In 1991 I left local work to work partially in sharing WBS with congregations throughout the United States. Since then I have spoken to over 480 congregations and I look forward to meeting many in Heaven who came to Jesus via this tool. WBS is used extensively in Cameroon. Jean Claude Ete has told me that 75% of all of the members of the church on the French side came via WBS. Even if the number were 10% it would be impressive. We take WBS material on every trip and give it to local churches for their outreach. Many Americans are teaching more Cameroonians than I can count via this tool. We have a great infrastructure of preachers to provide follow-up. Please pray that this work continues to flourish.

In June a team of four Americans plus myself plan to go again. Several Cameroonians will travel with us and, with the help of the Lord, we will work with 15 congregations. Be praying for those we teach. Pray for us that we will have a Christ like spirit and that Jesus will shine through us.

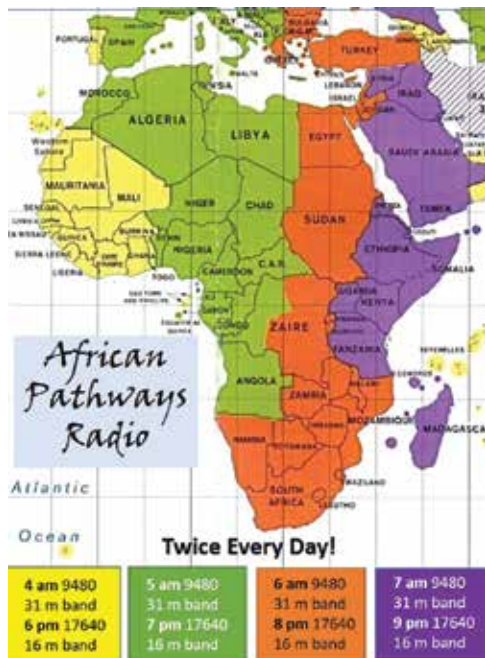

WCB Now Broadcasting from Madagascar!

Launch increases world coverage.

On March 27 World Christian Broadcasting began operations from its new station in the Indian Ocean. This station and the one in Alaska are able to reach most of the world by shortwave. Russian, Chinese and International English broadcasts have been going out from Alaska for over 30 years. Now, after many international preparations, the new station adds Arabic, Spanish and English for Africa. All languages broadcast hour-long programs a number of times each day.

Every day in the Africa hour (known as African Pathways Radio), John Reese delivers two advertisements for free World Bible School courses. Are these being heard? "1848 UTC—John Reese of World Bible School—enroll in a free Bible course... write to WBS address in Harare, Zimbabwe."

Thank you for sending me to Nigeria to Preach Christ and Him crucified! I have just completed my last mission trip to Nigeria, and all went well! I thank God for watching over me and the Nigerian brethren I travelled with around the southern part of Nigeria, keeping us safe and healthy as we worked for Him! This year, we conducted World Bible School Seminars in seven states: Oyo, Ogun, Ondo, Edo, Abia, Cross River and Adwa Ibom. We held three Leadership Seminars: one in Edo State and two in Akwa Ibom State. We visited two Nigerian Schools of Preaching: Southwest School of Preaching (SWSE) in Oyo State and the Nigerian Institute of Arts and Theological Studies (NIATS) in Abia State. We encouraged both staff and students at each school to continue their training of men to preach the word of God to their people.

While in Nigeria on this preaching mission, I witnessed 41 Nigerians obeying the Gospel of Christ. Not only that, but as we went on our "missionary journey" conducting our seminars, we would receive phone calls from church leaders where we had conducted a seminar a few days before, and they would report more who had been at the Seminar who later obeyed the Gospel. Wonderful!

For me, the highlight of my mission trip took place at The Great Workshop 2016—held at the Nigerian Christian Bible College (NCBC) in Ukpom-Abak, Akwa Ibom State—where attendance far exceeded anything we had imagined! The registered preachers numbered 746!

Plan to Saturate Your Community

John Reese — CEDAR PARK, Texas

Following the editorial about Mark 16:15, let's explore practical saturation. Suppose that a church of 50 members has been in a town of 50,000 for 50 years. Assuming more years, why not systematically plan to fulfil the Great Commission locally, while also reaching abroad? This is the time to repent, then prayerfully apply the wisdom God abundantly gives the single-minded (James 1:5-8). In planning, emphasize the Lord's directly-spoken priorities. That will re-align energies and funding.



But suppose that, even with generous effort and giving, only a fraction of the town can be saturated in any given year. Then do the part that can be done! Along with personal efforts, in affordable segments plan systematic mailings of World Bible School's campaign tools: *The Way* and *This is Good News*. The first year, provide attractive Gospel opportunities to one segment of, let's say, 10,000 people. The second year, target the next 10,000, and so on. After five years, start the cycle again. The task is never completed while society is dynamic. People move around for jobs. New generations grow up. Interests and avenues of communication change. In cycle after cycle, both locally and abroad, keep benefiting from lessons learned and new tools provided.

Someone may complain, "The responses do not justify this sort of money (besides, the parking lot needs re-paving)." Mark 16 reads the same whether our community is receptive or unreceptive (and whatever the parking lot's condition). We cannot force responses or guarantee growth, which limits some goal-setting. But we can set and hit reasonable goals for *distributing Gospel seed*. The increase is God's part, which He will honor fully. After all, this is His mission into which He invites us as partners (1 Corinthians 3:6-9).

Also use Connect US to reach out

Overlaying a segmented strategy, Web Ads can cover the entire population of 50,000. In any sizeable population, seekers are typing search words into their computers. Let the Gospel be there for them through WBS Connect, which also engages members as teachers. Every member can use a supply of 'business' cards pointing to an attractive Connect Web site and postal offer.

(Neutral addresses help to gain a hearing where pre-conceived ideas block reception.) Parallel to neutral tools, promote the church in community events and through publications like *House to House* (page 6).

Seekers are typing search words on the Internet. Reach them with WBS Web Ads.

Continuing the editorial thought... OK, so you are not a Coca-Cola manager facing the CEO's question, "Did you saturate your region?" But a similar meeting is scheduled for you. "We must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ.... Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade others" (2 Corinthians 5:10-11). How will you answer the Master when He asks about "every creature" within your reach?
