GHANA BIBLE READING PROJECT



God is opening a door of opportunity in Ghana! The Ghanaian government plans to open 200 new schools over the next 3 years, with the first group opening in September 2015. Each school will have up to 600 students. The schools will be required to teach Religious & Moral Education (RME), which creates the need for ongoing Bible teaching. Dr. Augustine Tawiah (a government consultant and himself a convert through WBS) has arranged to field RME teachers with WBS materials at these new schools. That's thousands of new WBS students on an ongoing basis!

WBS is working to make the most of this unprecedented opportunity to impress the Bible onto the next generation of Ghanaians. But to succeed, we need your help. We will soon begin looking for up to 60 churches willing to adopt and teach a school in Ghana. Christians at these churches will serve as study helpers and use the WBS scanning system for prompt communication.

Please prayerfully consider how your church can participate in this great effort. As details of the project emerge, we will be in touch. In the meantime, pray that all the parts, and your part, move forward smoothly.

STUDENT NAMES ON LESSONS

Recently, we have seen several instances where the same student name appears on several Intro lesson return sheets. In each case it appeared that a teacher sent a batch of lessons with no student name inserted in the **blue student box** on Return Page 1. Then, a student filled out several, and wrote their name and address in the blue box and mailed them back. This is obviously a waste of materials and postage, since one person has no need to complete and return six Intro lessons. PLEASE, when you prepare lessons for mailing, address not only the outside of the lesson booklet/envelope, but also put a specific student's name and mailing address into the **blue student box** on Return Page 1.
