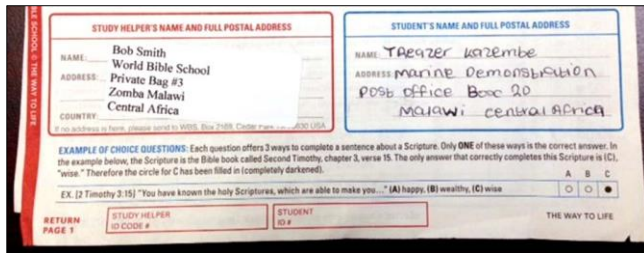

The photo at left shows a WBS Intro lesson we recently received at the WBS office in Cedar Park TX. This lesson, and four others to the same study helper, were sent to us so we could forward them to the student's study helper for grading. Unfortunately on all five lessons the study helper did not write his congregation's code number in the "Study helper ID Code #" box on the bottom left side

of the page. Without that code number, we don't know where to send these five lessons. We did forward the lessons to another study helper, so they will be graded and returned to the student. Unfortunately, the study helper won't know what happened, and the students will wonder why they now have a different study helper. Help us get your lessons back to you every time. Always enter your code number in the red box!!
